Call for Special Issue Proposals for World Leisure Journal

Colleagues wishing to propose a Special Issue should submit an outline of up to 1,000 words which summarises the key aims and

proposed theme(s) to be explored, how the issue will build upon work published previously in the journal and field more widely, and topics on which papers would be sought. A short CV (no more than 2 pages) for each editor outlining their expertise, relevant publications and editorial experience should also be submitted.

Shortlisted proposals will be considered by the Editor-in-Chief and the World Leisure Journal Editorial Board in May 2023 with outcomes communicated as soon as possible thereafter. It is anticipated that the selected special issues will be published between 2024 and 2025 by agreement with the Guest Editors.
