Introduction

The Thomas and Ruth Rivers International Scholarship Award was established in 1970. The Scholarship is awarded biennially in conjunction with the World Leisure Congress. Funding for the scholarship is provided by World Leisure Organization, sponsorships, and individual contributions.

Purpose

The Thomas and Ruth Rivers International Scholarship Award is intended to provide opportunities for senior or graduate or university programs, to attend and present a scholarly paper at the biennial international World Leisure Congress. The focus of the paper should be on any aspect of recreation, leisure and/or tourism from a worldwide perspective. It is envisioned that students will gain a broader perspective of world leisure, recreation and tourism trends, issues, philosophies and problems. Upon return to their respective institutions, the scholarship recipients are expected to share their experiences with fellow students, colleagues and professors.

The Scholarship

The Thomas and Ruth Rivers International Scholarship Award provides the scholarship recipient the opportunity to attend and participate in an international congress. The recipient is provided a world-wide forum for the presentation of a scholarly paper.

The scholarship recipient is awarded a scholarship of **USD \$1.000** to cover the costs associated with attending the 2023 World Leisure Congress to be held in Dunedin, New Zealand, from December 11th to 15th, 2023. The recipient will also receive **free registration** to the Congress, and **Premium Student Membership** for 2023-2024.

The scholarship recipient is expected to provide the funds to cover additional costs.

Eligibility

To be eligible as the scholarship recipient, the applicant shall:

- (1) be a final year graduate or undergraduate in a college or university program, from any country of the world, with a major in recreation, leisure studies, leisure services, leisure resources or tourism studies
- (2) have a cumulative grade point average of: 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, if an undergraduate, or 3.8 on a 4.0 scale, if a graduate
- (3) be recommended by two faculty members in his or her college or university department
- (4) have exhibited interest in recreation, leisure and/or tourism internationally
- (5) have had either volunteer or paid work experience in the recreation/leisure services or tourism fields
- (6) be a member of World Leisure Organization (go to <https://www.worldleisure.org/become-a-member/> to join under the free membership)
- (7) submit an abstract through the 2023 World Leisure Congress website. If not done yet, follow these steps:
 - Access the 2023 World Leisure Congress website: <https://www.worldleisure.org/call-for-abstracts>
 - Scroll down and click on the "Submit your abstract here" button
 - Create a new account at the Call for abstracts portal
 - Follow the instructions given and fulfill the required information

**Please note that Abstracts must be clearly written in English and be a maximum of 300 words excluding the title and authors.*

- (8) if the college or university does not have a major in recreation, leisure studies/services or tourism, the applicant shall obtain a letter from his or her major professor indicating the major area of study as such; and
- (9) if the college or university does not require course work, the applicant shall obtain, from his or her major professor, a letter indicating the applicant's required learning/research activities and a performance evaluation of the applicant.

Selection of Recipients

After reviewing the application and supporting material of each scholarship applicant, the final selection of the recipient will be made by the Thomas and Ruth Rivers International Scholarship Award Committee. Selections will be made without regard to race, color, ethnicity, religion, sex, sexual orientation, national origin or disability. Alternates will be designated in the event the successful applicant is not able to attend the Congress.

Application Procedures

Students applying for the Thomas and Ruth Rivers International Scholarship Award shall:

- (1) Submit an abstract through the 2023 World Leisure Congress website. If not done yet, please follow the steps indicated in the Eligibility section, point (7). **Please note that Abstracts acceptance and TRRIS application are two different processes. The evaluation of the TRRIS application is subject to the acceptance of the abstract through the regular process for abstracts submission at the 2023 World Leisure Congress website > Call for abstract. In case of acceptance of your abstract at this first stage (via 2023 World Leisure Congress Call for abstracts), then it will be evaluated by the TRRIS committee together with your application form.**
- (2) Complete Part I of the Application Form and submit the Supplemental Documentation requested in Part II of the application.
- (3) Submit the Faculty Validation of Student Applicant form (see page 4) to a faculty member or advisor in the student's college/university department and request that it be completed and emailed to the Program Manager of the Thomas and Ruth Rivers International Scholarship Award Committee, along with a letter from the student's major professor.

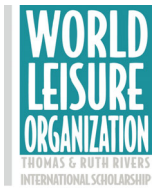
